How do you know which church to attend?

Is God willing to show me which church?

James 1:5-6 If any of you <u>lack wisdom</u>, let him <u>ask of God</u>, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. But let him <u>ask in faith, nothing wavering</u>..."

But how do you know if God will answer your prayer?

Deuteronomy 4:29 But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.

Will God show us his will?

"For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God..." (Ecclesiastes 2:26) God rewards us according to our ways.

We are often not willing to be led... Do we really want God's wisdom? Proverbs 3:6 says, "In <u>all thy ways acknowledge him</u>, and he shall direct thy paths."

What should I look for in a church?

- 1. Jesus' church is a place where <u>He is the foundation</u> of the church. It is a place where the Bible is the basis for doctrine.
- 2. 1 John 4:8 "He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love." A church that belongs to Jesus will have some **genuine love** for people. Not just for those who give, not just for those who attend.
- 3. Matthew 11:29 "Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart:" Meek churches will have meek people.
- 4. 1 Corinthians 3:17 "...for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are. " Jesus' church has people who are trying to become holy.

I recommend a good Baptist church...Ask God to show you if it is His will. If He says yes, ask God which one.

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Do you know for sure you are forgiven and going to heaven?

Dear friend, God gives grace to the humble...Are we humble enough to believe God 's written words, the Bible? (God wants us be sure!)

- 1. We are all sinners. Romans 3:23 says, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" Romans 3:10, "As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:"
- The wages of sin is death. Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Hebrews 9:27, "And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:"

These wages include a 2nd death:

Revelation 21:8, "But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

God loves you (John 3:16) and wants you to choose his mercy rather than judgment. Il Peter 3:9 says "The Lord is ... not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." (Note we have a free will.)

3. God has provided for your salvation through Jesus Christ. Romans 5:8, "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Il Corinthians 5:21, "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him." Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

God has a gift for you. You can't earn it. It is free. (Ephesians 2:8-9) Jesus died for you. (Romans 5:8) Jesus was buried. (Acts 13:29) God raised him from the dead (Acts 13:30).

4. Call on Jesus for him to save you. Romans 10:13, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Romans 10:9-11, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.'

(Example prayer) Dear Jesus, I accept you as my Saviour <u>forever</u>. Forgive me of all my sins. Please take me to Heaven when I die; and please save me from Hell. Thank you for dying for me. Amen.

The Bible teaches repentance toward God and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. Do you believe He loved you enough to die for your sins and that God rose up Christ from the dead? If you did not yet trust Him as your Saviour, please do so right now.

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
